





EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

An appointed committee, chaired by the Scholarship Chairman, shall judge all applications received from students who meet established criteria. The following point system will be used for the evaluation of each application:

- 40% Academic Record
- 25% Applicant's Essay
- 20% Applicant's Financial Need
- 10% Applicant's Honors/Extracurricular Activities/ Work Experience
- 5% Signed Letter's of Recommendation

Selection is competitive and will be based solely upon the above point system. Written notification of award of scholarship will be mailed in during 7 June 2007.

Purpose

The Second Missionary Baptist Church (SMBC) scholarship program exists to financially assist those qualified individuals seeking to attend an accredited institution of higher learning.

Mission Statement

The mission of the Second Missionary Baptist Church Scholarship Committee is to financially assist in the educational endeavors of the college bound youth of SMBC and the local community.

Scholarship Fund

The SMBC Scholarship Fund was created in 2004. The SMBC Scholarship Fund has been established as a self-perpetuating scholarship fund from the generous donations of church members, community and business partners. Those funds will be divided into two types of scholarships:

General Scholarships - which are available to graduating High School Seniors.

Scholarship Grants - which are available to those continuing their education as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior.

Second Missionary Baptist Church may choose not to make an award in any given year.

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant:

- ✚ Must be a member in good standing with their Christian church of choice with a letter from their Pastor.

- ✚ Accepted at a fully accredited college, university or seminary.

- ✚ Must have established and maintained a satisfactory academic record of a 2.5 (C+) grade point average.

Members of underrepresented groups including women, minorities and persons with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

Application Requirements

Applications must contain:

- ✚ Biography of self w/5x7 Picture
- ✚ SMBC Application Form
- ✚ Official Transcripts with Seal
- ✚ Three (3) Letter's of Recommendation, with original signatures
- ✚ Letter of acceptance to the college or university of choice
- ✚ Certified Copies of Honor Accolades
- ✚ 800 to 1000 word Essay MLA Format

Essay topic is "Reaching Beyond the Dream in My Lifetime." Essays must contain 800 to 1000 words written in MLA format.

Upon completion, applications with required materials must be submitted or postmarked by 30 April 2007. NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
